HIGH SCHOOL DRAWING EXHIBITION 2012

entry guidelines

The New Hampshire Institute of Art is pleased to announce the High School Drawing Exhibition 2012, a national, juried exhibition for high school students. This exhibition will be on display in the French Building Gallery from February 24–March 17, 2012.

ENTRY AND CD LABELING

- **Preliminary judging of entries will be done from digital images. It is imperative that your images are of professional quality. Poor quality images may be disqualified at the juror's discretion.**
- Digital images submitted must be 300 dpi, with largest dimension no larger than 6", jpeg format.
- Please label image: artistsname.jpg (example-awilliams.jpg)
- All disks sent must be labeled with the artist's full name, title of work, dimension and medium. Please use paper envelope sleeves — no jewel cases. Mail in a padded envelope.
- Disks cannot be returned — please make sure you have a copy of your images for your records.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

- Entries must be original drawings created by current high school students (current as of December 2011).
- Original artwork, including mat, must not exceed 28"x36".
- Only artwork in drawing media and completed in the last TWO years will be accepted.
- Drawings from photographs or other printed materials may not qualify for award consideration but may be juried into the exhibit at the juror's discretion.
- Only 1 entry may be submitted by each artist.
- Attn: High School Art Teachers: Please submit one disk per student.
- Registration forms must be signed. Registration forms will be available on our website: www.nhia.edu. You may also photocopy this form.
- **Image and registration form are due January 13, 2012.**

Any incomplete application or images that are not labeled correctly or are of poor quality may not be eligible for entry.

JUDGING AND JUROR

An outside juror will be invited to jury the submitted work. The juror will view the entries individually and has the option, upon receipt of the entries, of rejecting from the exhibition any works that do not meet the eligibility requirements and restrictions.

NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE

Accepted work will be posted to our website at www.nhia.edu on January 27, 2012. Students will also receive notification through the mail along with additional paperwork.

ACCEPTED ARTWORK RESTRICTIONS

- Drawings are required to be matted in white mats.
- Original artwork, including mat, must not exceed 28"x36".
- Charcoal and pastel drawings must be fixed with archival fixative.
- Work must be labeled on back using Entry Form provided upon acceptance.
- All artwork must be delivered in clear, protective plastic bags or sleeves.

DELIVERY OF ACCEPTED ARTWORK

Artworks selected for the High School Drawing Exhibition must be received by 6pm, February 20, 2012.

In-Person:

If you choose to deliver the artwork in person it must be between the hours of 9am – 6 pm, February 20, 2012.

Artwork sent by common carrier must be received by 6 pm, February 20, 2012.

Return shipments of artwork, shipped by common carrier, will be shipped back in original container and paid for by the New Hampshire Institute of Art.

LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

All artwork will be insured against loss or damage while on exhibit at the Institute. While work is in transit, coming to and returning from the Institute, liability and insurance are the responsibility of the artist. Insurance value cannot exceed \$100.
