**ANNUAL FACULTY SHOW

MANCHESTER, NH – The New Hampshire Institute of Art will host its annual faculty exhibition beginning with an opening reception, September 5th, 2007 from 5-7 pm. Artwork will be on display through September 22nd within the campus's three galleries: Amherst Street Gallery, 77 Amherst Street; Main Building Gallery, 148 Concord Street; Fuller Hall Gallery, 165 Hanover Street. All buildings are located in downtown Manchester.

The exhibit will highlight artwork from the Institute's diverse group of talented instructors. Works will range in various mediums: painting, sculpture, photography, ceramic, drawing and print, as well as jewelry and multi-media pieces will be on display. Many of the works are for sale.

Returning faculty will present new works, and recently hired faculty will also show pieces displaying their particular mediums. Instructors at the New Hampshire Institute of Art are practicing, professional artists and hail from a wide range of educational facilities across the United States and Europe, including the Rhode Island School of Design, Indiana University and the Glasgow School of Art, Glasgow, Scotland.
